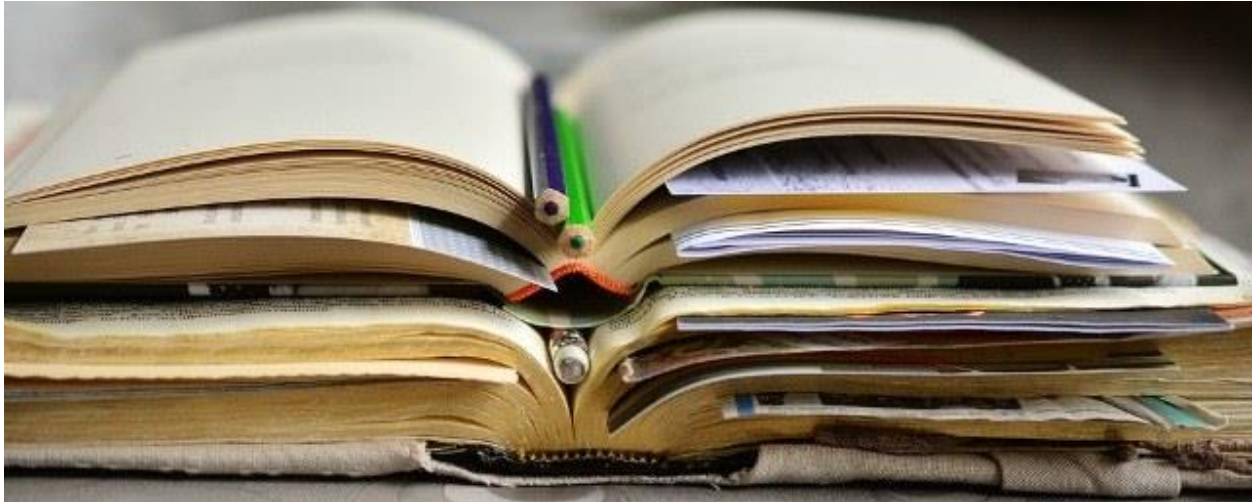

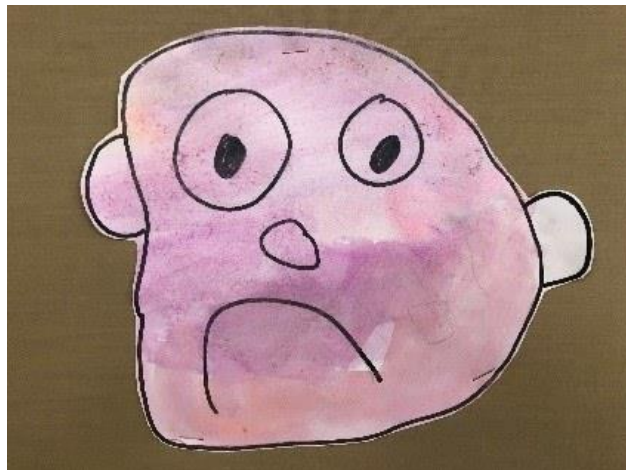

Learning News B9



In B9 we have been learning about all the different feelings that people can have. We have learnt to look at people's faces to work out how they are feeling. Somebodies eyes, eyebrows and mouth can show us how they are feeling. Sometimes when feelings are big they make our bodies feel different. We drew around one of the students and then recorded all the places in our body that we might feel those big feelings. Some of the ones we thought of were clenched fists, a yelling voice and stomping feet for feeling angry. The butterflies in the tummy were for feeling scared or worried. We have also learnt about what we can do at school if we have big feelings. We have learnt about the different zones that people can be in. The green zone is when you are calm and ready for learning. The blue, yellow and red zones are not good zones to learn in so we have talked about ways to get back to the green learning zone. We have each made a zones plan which can help us get back to the green zone.

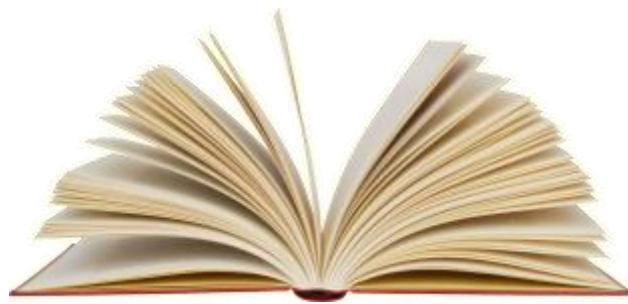


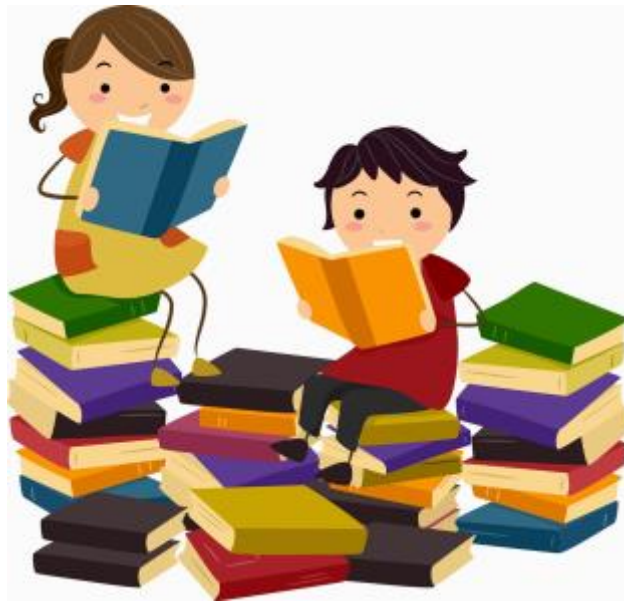






Library News

APPLYING FOR A SCHOOL CARD



All types of School Card applications are now online.

You can access the online forms from any device that gets internet, including mobile devices, such as tablets and smart phones, as well as laptops and computers.

Applying online is easy! Simply follow the steps below.

- STEP 1** Visit sa.gov.au/education/schoolcard
- STEP 2** Select the type of School Card you would like to apply for (for example 'Type A') and follow the prompts.
- STEP 3** Complete all mandatory fields.
Please note: you cannot submit your application unless all mandatory fields are complete.
- STEP 4** Once you have completed a page click on the 'NEXT' button.
- STEP 5** Once you have filled out all pages click the 'SUBMIT' button.
Please note: if you exit the form without clicking 'SUBMIT' your details will be lost.

You can save the form, and return to complete it at another time, by clicking on the 'SAVE' button.
